

Members receive our monthly digital newsletter, *The Cotton Patch Rag* and the satisfaction of supporting and promoting live Folk music and Americana in the greater Houston area. **Dues are \$20 a year per individual membership, and \$35 per couple (includes 2 email addresses).** Second Saturday Concerts become Second <u>Sunday</u> Concerts in Fall 2024 and are moving to St. Andrew's Presbyterian!
