## BEN BEDFORD



"Ben Bedford isn't gunning for poet laureate of Illinois but if ever there was an equivalent honor for a singer-songwriter he'd have to be in the running."

In July of 2010, Bedford was named one of the "50 most significant Folk singer-songwriters of the past 50 years" by Rich Warren of WFMT-Chicago. The list also included Bob Dylan, Townes Van Zandt, Anais Mitchell, Joni Mitchell, and Danny Schmidt. In May of 2018, Bedford was named one of the six Grassy Hill Kerrville New Folk winners at the Kerrville Folk Festival in Texas. He has toured extensively over the past 15 years in North America and western Europe. In January of 2023, he'll release his sixth studio album, Valley Of Stars, engineered and mixed by David Sinko (Yo-Yo Ma, Punch Brothers, Edgar Meyer) and featuring Ethan Jodziewicz (Aoife O'Donovan, Maya de Vitry, Milk Carton Kids) on bass, Chas Williams (Nanci Griffith) on second guitar, and Kari Floyd on harmony vocals.

## Houston folklorist's storied blues and jazz archive finds home at Smithsonian

Folklorist and historian Robert "Mack" McCormick speaks to Fourth Ward residents while in search of Snowball Horton. McCormick was a crucial documentarian of African-American music forms.



"McCormick was a self-trained folklorist who built a vast blues archive, with research materials on hundreds of artists. He was a Pennsylvania native who spent time in Ohio and Louisiana before settling in Houston, where he began writing about jazz in 1949. He began documenting and collecting musical histories and artifacts in the 1950s, but the archive contains items dating well before that. He was a prolific researcher and writer who grew his collection even as he lived with mental illness during the later decades of his life.

"McCormick's archive has long been of near-mythical proportions within research and music history circles, and it lives up to its promise," said John Troutman, curator of music for the Smithsonian." [Read More](#)

## HEY FOR CHRISTMAS

I am pretty sure the good Master Purcell did not write the words, which tell of a festive and rather bawdy Christmas celebration, which apparently was not unusual in seventeenth century England. 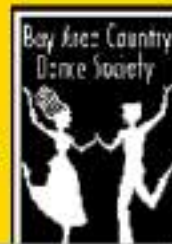
