Second Saturday Concert is excited to welcome singer-songwriter Steve Fisher to our stage once again. About this true songwriter's songwriter, John Fullbright says: "My friend Steve Fisher is... "one of the greatest songwriters that ever put pen to paper." Fullbright goes on to caution concert goers that "Steve is one of those *twist-the-knife-it's-so beautiful* songwriters, so maybe bring a tissue. "Songwriter Buddy Mondlock recently explained who Steve is, saying "Steve Fisher is the guy you wander around the Kerrville Folk Festival campground at 4AM looking for so you can hear that amazing baritone voice."

During Steve's decades as a masterful songwriter, his writing and recording have been prolific, though he has limited touring in preference of living in the moment and crafting powerful, soulful, beautiful music. We are greatly honored to have him return to our Second Saturday stage.
