The Truth Can Be Surprising At Times




In my volunteer work as a teacher of guitar, I have encountered a notion put forth by several students as


they begin their music lessons. They imagine that since the note names begin with A, B, C ... that the naming goes on through the alphabet. It takes them some time to grasp that the notes repeat after reaching G. However, it has not always been this way. At one time in Scandinavia and Germany, the naming continued on to "H"! It is alleged that the natural note "B" had been transcribed to an "H" as it was misinterpreted by monks doing a transcription of musical notation. The "Bb" was identified as note "B". Johann Sebastian Bach appreciated this convention and from time to time inserted this motif into a composition.

BEYOND THE MATHEMATICS OF SPECIAL RELATIVITY

Many of us have seen and heard Einstein's most famous equation which comes from his Special Theory of Relativity. However, those who play music are aware of two more of his equations which he derived after observing that there are no black keys on the piano between the B & C and E & F keys.





Born Joseph Emmanuel Hagglund to Swedish-American parents in 1879, union activist and songwriter Joe Hill was executed for committing murder in 1915 in Salt Lake City. Documents uncovered in the 21st century strongly suggest that Hill was innocent. He was executed by a police firing squad. His political notoriety as a vigorous and effective organizer for the IWW may have influenced his conviction. Thus, with his death he became a towering martyr to the cause of organized labor. Joan Baez performed this song at Woodstock in 1969, and it was released as a single by Vanguard in 1970. I learned it from her recording. 




